
What to do if ICE is at your door!

“Know your rights” Checklist

At home

- ☐ DO NOT open the door.
- ☐ Ask for their identification.
- ☐ Ask to see a valid Judicial Warrant.
- ☐ If they have a valid warrant,
Step out and close the door *immediately*.
- ☐ By law, you must give your name and
your birthdate. DO NOT LIE!
- ☐ Exercise your right to remain silent.
- ☐ DO NOT sign anything.

At work

- ☐ DO NOT run.
- ☐ Go to a place “For Employees Only”
- ☐ Your employer should ask for identification.
- ☐ Your employer should ask to see a valid Judicial Warrant
- ☐ If they have a valid warrant, the person they are seeking
should step out and close the door immediately.
- ☐ Exercise your right to remain silent except for your name and
birthdate. Do Not Lie!
- ☐ DO NOT sign anything.
- ☐ Call 979-429-2930 to advise Migrant Justice Network and
ask for assistance

What a valid warrant has to have:

- Make sure the name on the order matches **EXACTLY** with the name on your identification
- Must be signed by a Judge.
- Must have the current date and the address of where they are trying to enter.
- Must say “Search Warrant and Affidavit” and “U.S. District Court” or “State Court” on the top of the form

If they do not have a valid warrant say: *“I do not consent to your entry.”*

IF THEY ENTER BY FORCE, DO NOT RESIST. Say: *“I do not consent to your entry or search of this property. I am exercising my right to remain silent. I would like to speak to an attorney as soon as possible.”.*
